## Could this be YOU?

Millie is in an internet cafe, trying to find pictures for her project about big cats. By accident, she finds some pictures and photographs that make her feel uncomfortable and embarrassed.

Millie was uncomfortable because she didn't like the images she saw and was worried someone might have seen her and she would get blamed. She told her mum when she got in who told her not to worry as it wasn't her fault. They talked about what was on the images, and Millie said she felt reassured that she could talk to her mum about internet problems.

## What to do if it happening to you?

If you tell an adult (teacher, parent, person in charge of the internet cafe, youth centre, school library, etc) then you too should be reassured like Millie was. Sometimes the adult will need to check that it really was an accident, but don't feel guilty however horrible the images are - its not your fault! If it keeps happening, use 'advanced search' features on your search engine to make sure you find the sites you want, not the ones you don't.
